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Setting Targets for FY 2015/16

- Amendments of the Local Government (PPDA) Regulations, Standard Bidding Documents and Guidelines.
- Implementation of E-Government procurement.
- Adoption of at least one reservation scheme.
- Advocate for the finalization of the contractors registration and classification system.
- Strengthen linkages with non-state actors in contract monitoring through Barazas.

Setting Targets for FY 2015/16

- Strengthen linkages with oversight and enforcement agencies including Parliamentary Accountability Committees, Auditor General, IGG, DPP and CIID.
- Focus on 15 High Spend Agencies to ensure alignment of procurement plans with budgets/work plans and strengthen contract management and performance.

Setting Targets for FY 2015/16

- lobby Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development to adopt the use of the Independent Parallel Bid Evaluation system for High Value contracts.
- Opening up of regional offices in Mbarara.
- Collaborate with competent Authorities to develop specifications for commonly procured items.
- Monitoring compliance through procurement audits PPMS and Administrative Reviews.

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- Commence construction of PPDA/URF Office after approval of the design.
- Follow-up on timely payment to contractors
- Contribute to national development by ensuring value for money.
- Capacity building for PDU staff and contractors
- Publish common user price list.
