THE ACT

Mandate: *An Act of Parliament to make provision for training, registration and licensing of supplies practitioners, to regulate their practice and for connected purposes*

- ✓ The Act establishes organs for development and regulation of procurement practice

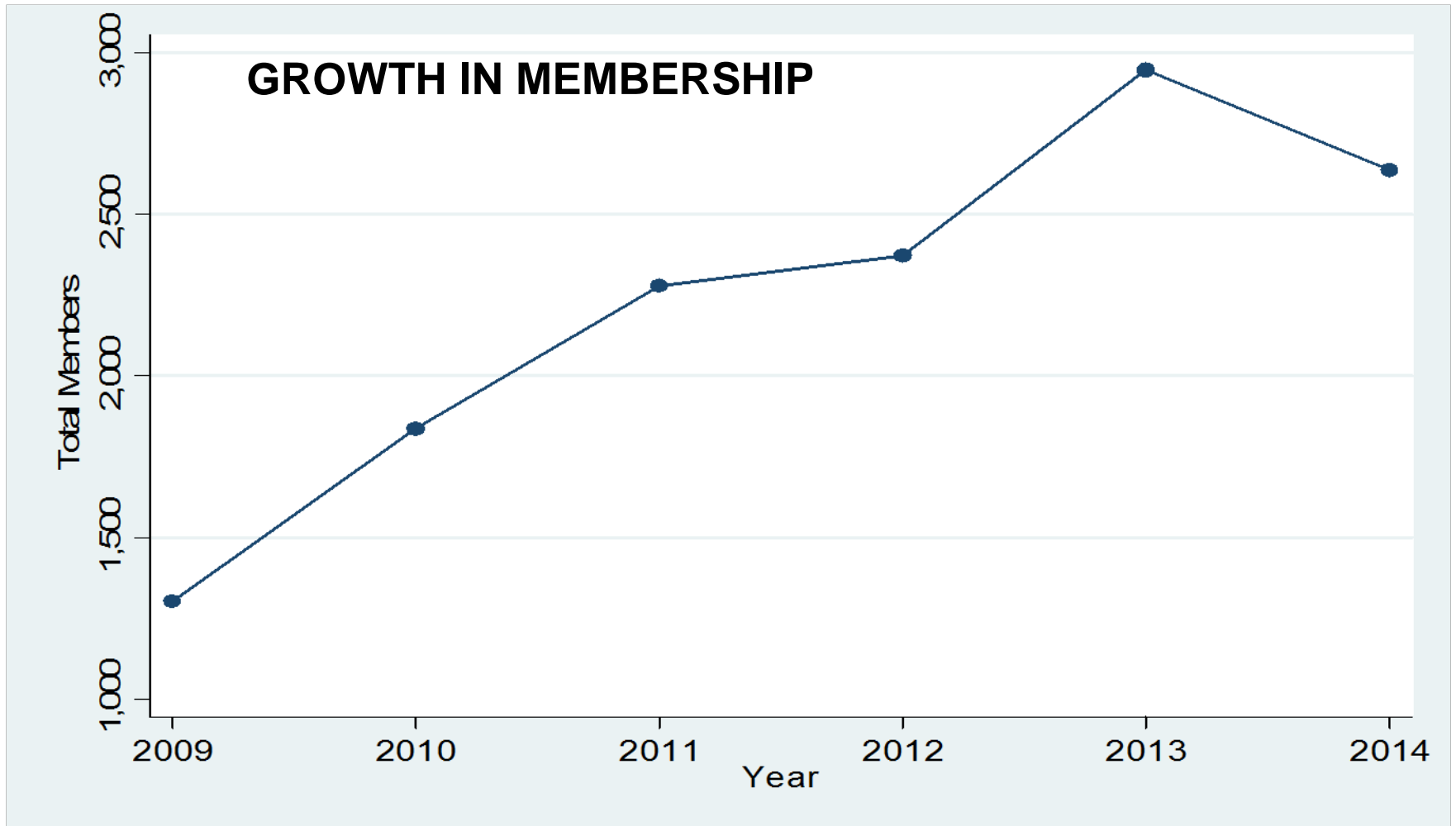
SENSITIZATION WORKSHOPS ON PROCUREMENT LAW

- A committee of the Council established under Section 22(1) of the Act to:
 - ✓ Enforcement of a professional code of ethics/conduct - receive and investigate complaints, hear cases and recommend disciplinary action

ENFORCEMENT - ETHICS

- Enforcement is supported through definition of offences that attract penalties (**Sec 29-33**):
 - ✓ Misrepresentation - practicing without registration/qualification
 - ✓ Employing unregistered/unqualified persons
 - ✓ Training without approvals from the Minister for Education

- Established under Section 12(1) of the Act to:
 - ✓ Develop syllabus of instruction
 - ✓ Prepare and issue professional certifying examinations in line with the syllabuses
 - ✓ Certify practitioners with respect to such examinations

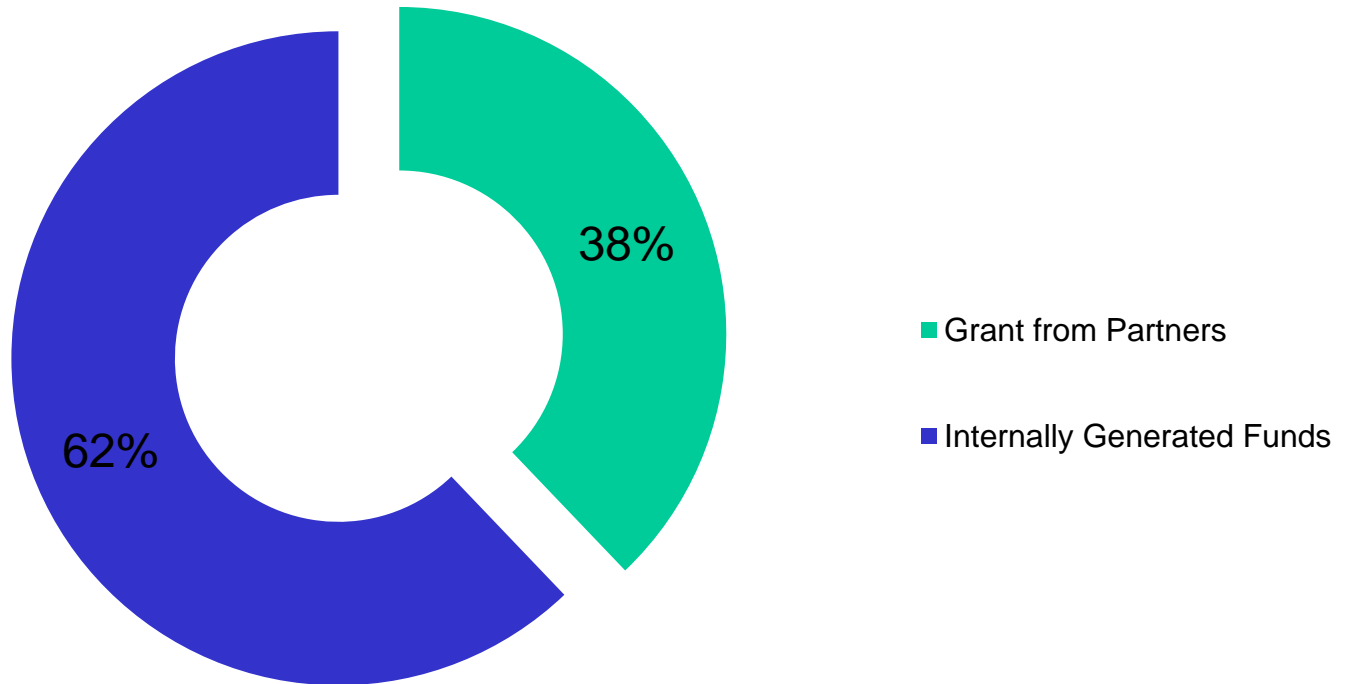
KENYA INSTITUTE OF SUPPLIES EXAMINATIONS BOARD
