INTERNSHIP AND VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY

The Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets Authority (PPDA) is established under the PPDA Act No.1 of 2003 to develop standards and regulate procurement and disposal practices in respect of all Procuring and Disposing Entities which include Central Government Ministries and Departments, Local Governments, State Enterprises, Constitutional and Statutory Bodies and post primary training institutions.

1. Information Technology (Intern)

REQUIREMENTS

A continuing student pursuing Bachelors degree in Information Technology from a recognized university.

2. Legal (Volunteer)

EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS

A Bachelors Honours degree in Law from a recognized University.

TERMS OF ENGAGEMENT

- The duration of internship shall be a maximum of three months.
- Volunteer services shall not exceed six months.
- The Intern and Volunteer shall not be entitled to any salary and benefits
