What is E – Procurement

- Electronic Procurement is the business to business –B2B (or Government to Business G2B) purchase and sale of supplies and services through the Internet.
- A system that uses ICT in the management, processing and reporting for the acquisition of goods, works and services through the internet.

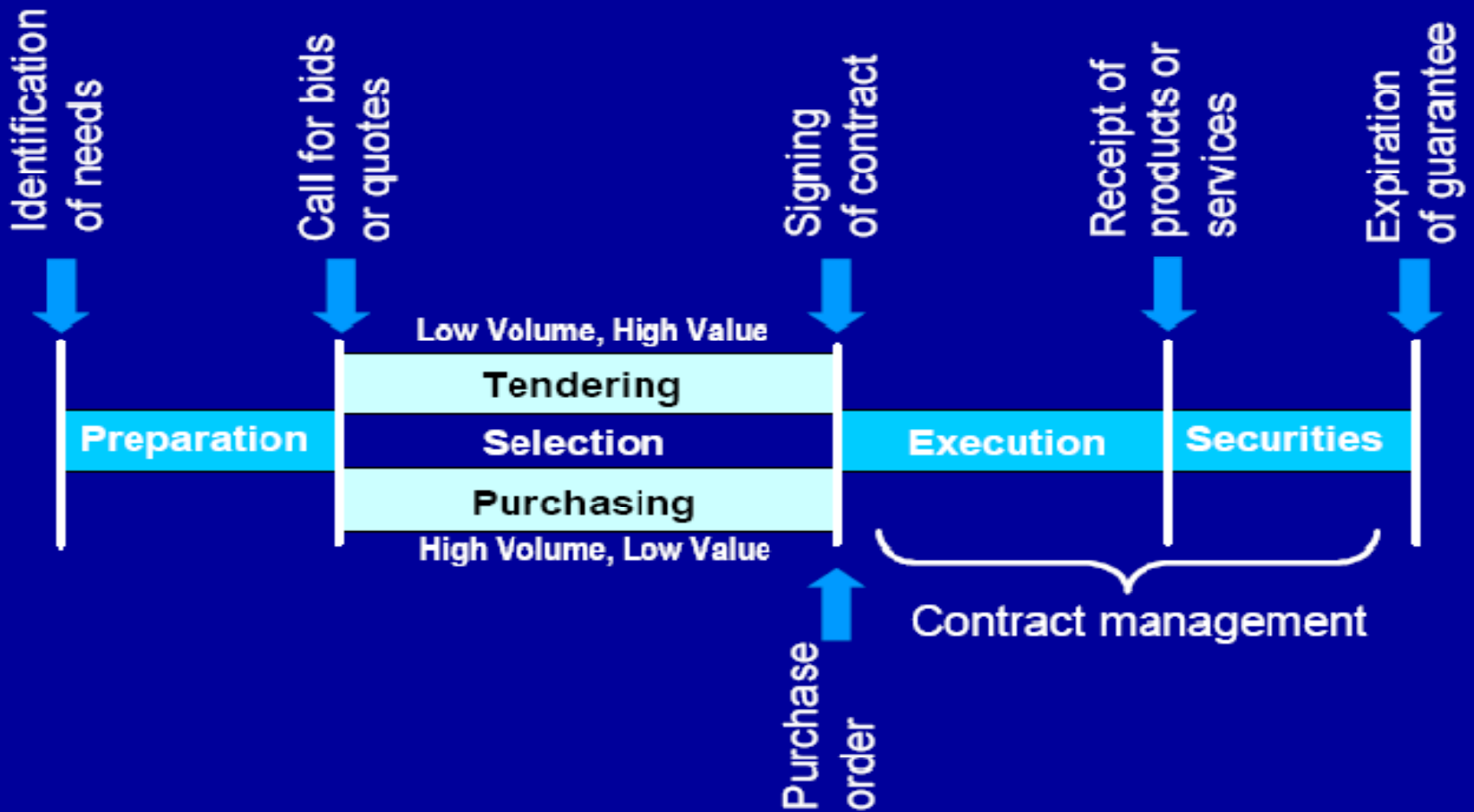

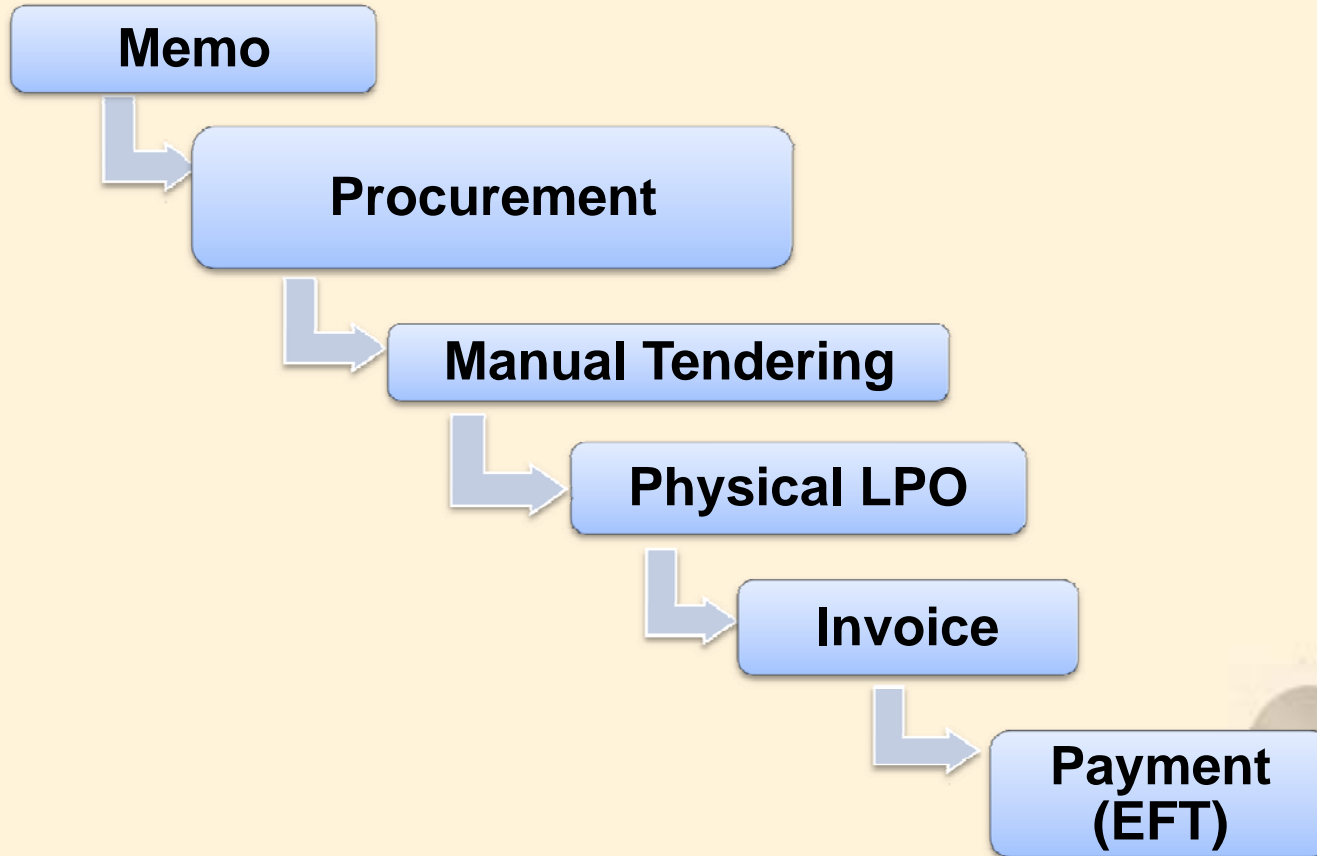

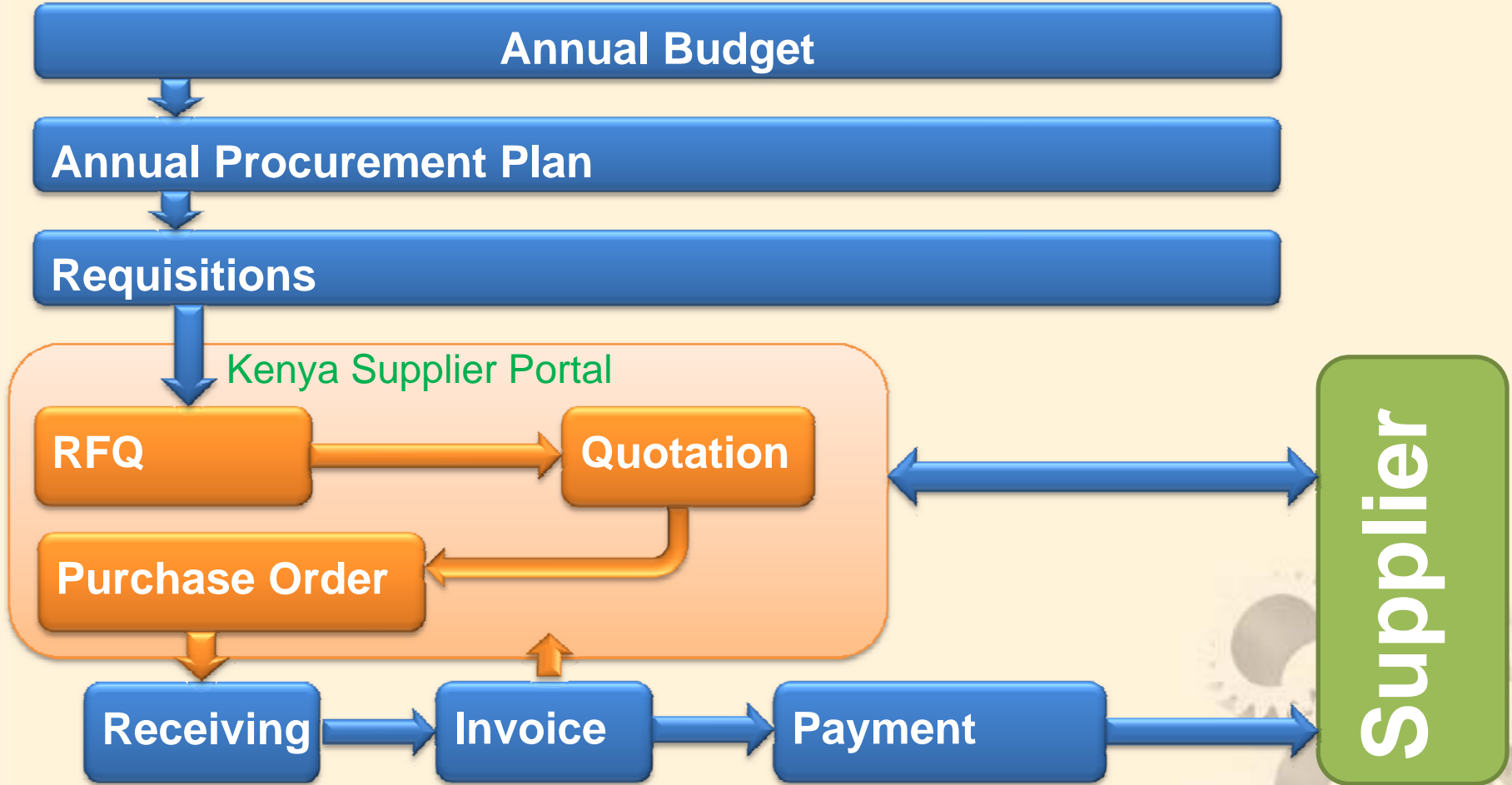
Government Procurement Processes

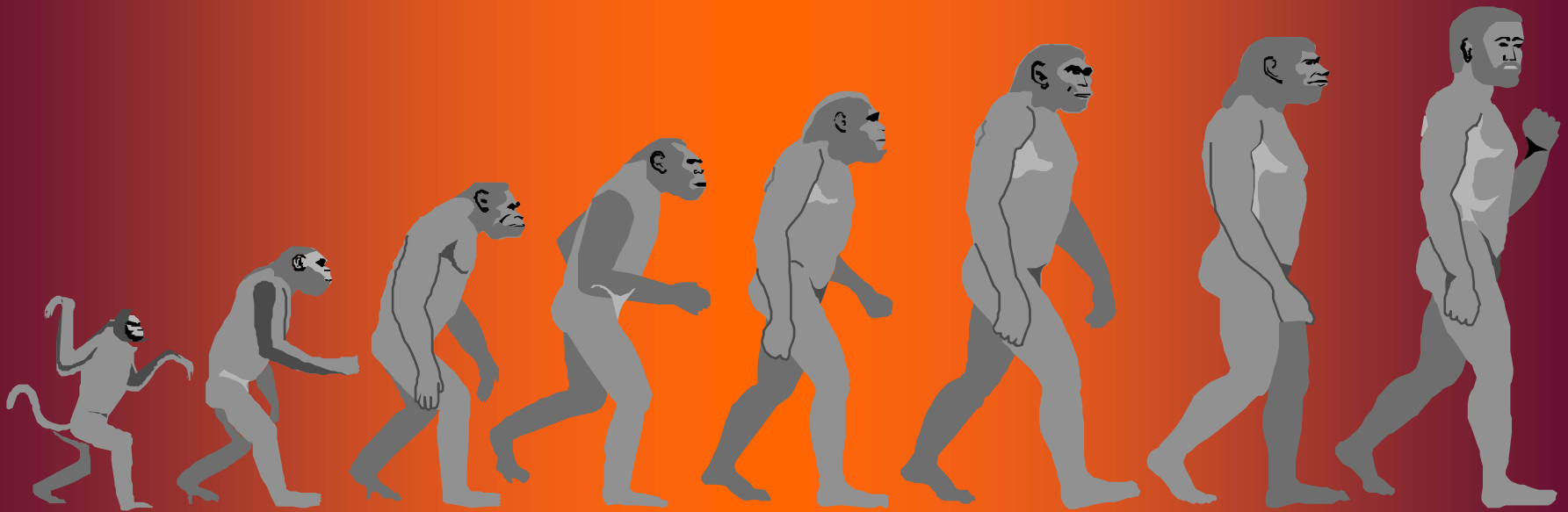


Advantages of e-Procurement

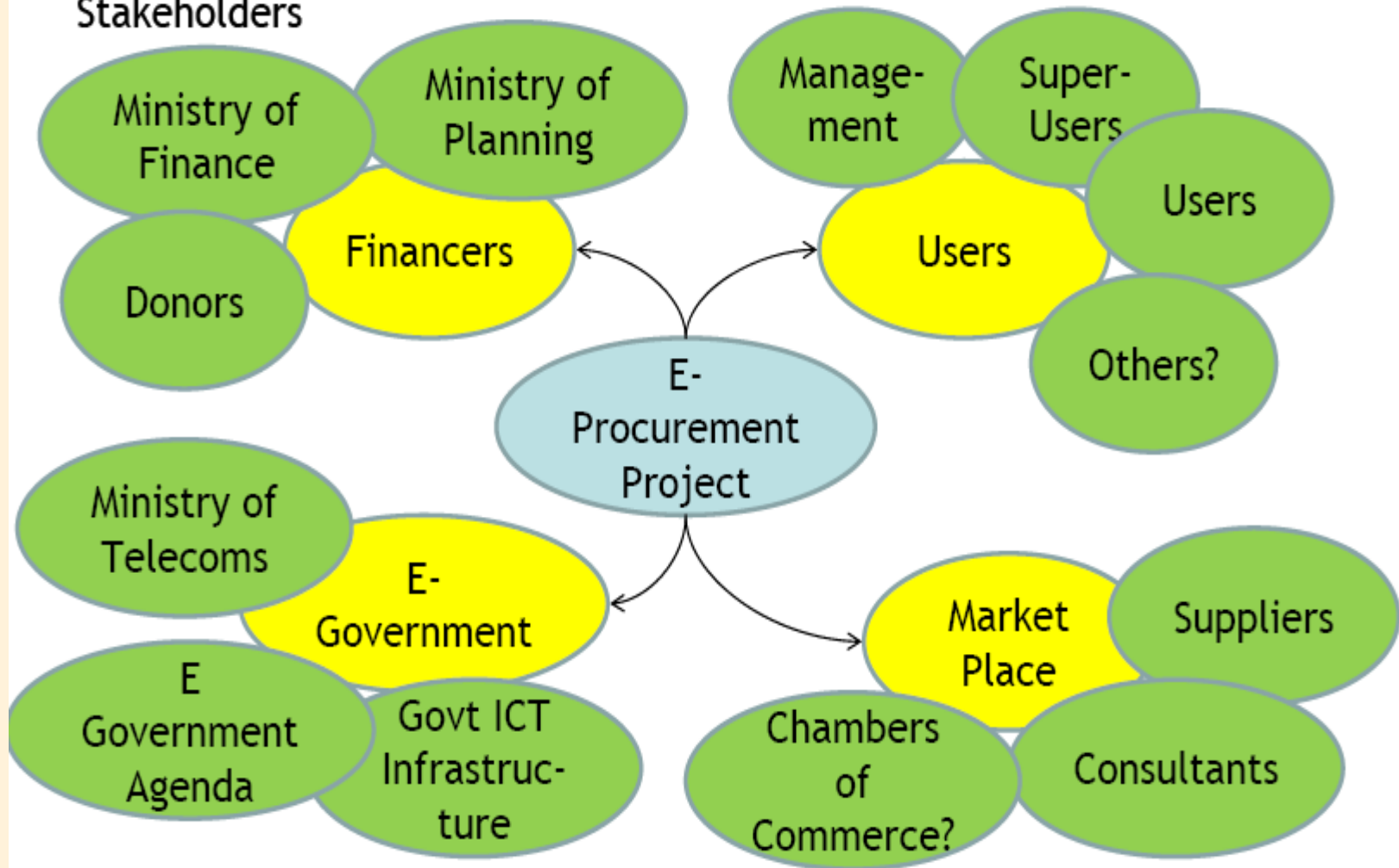

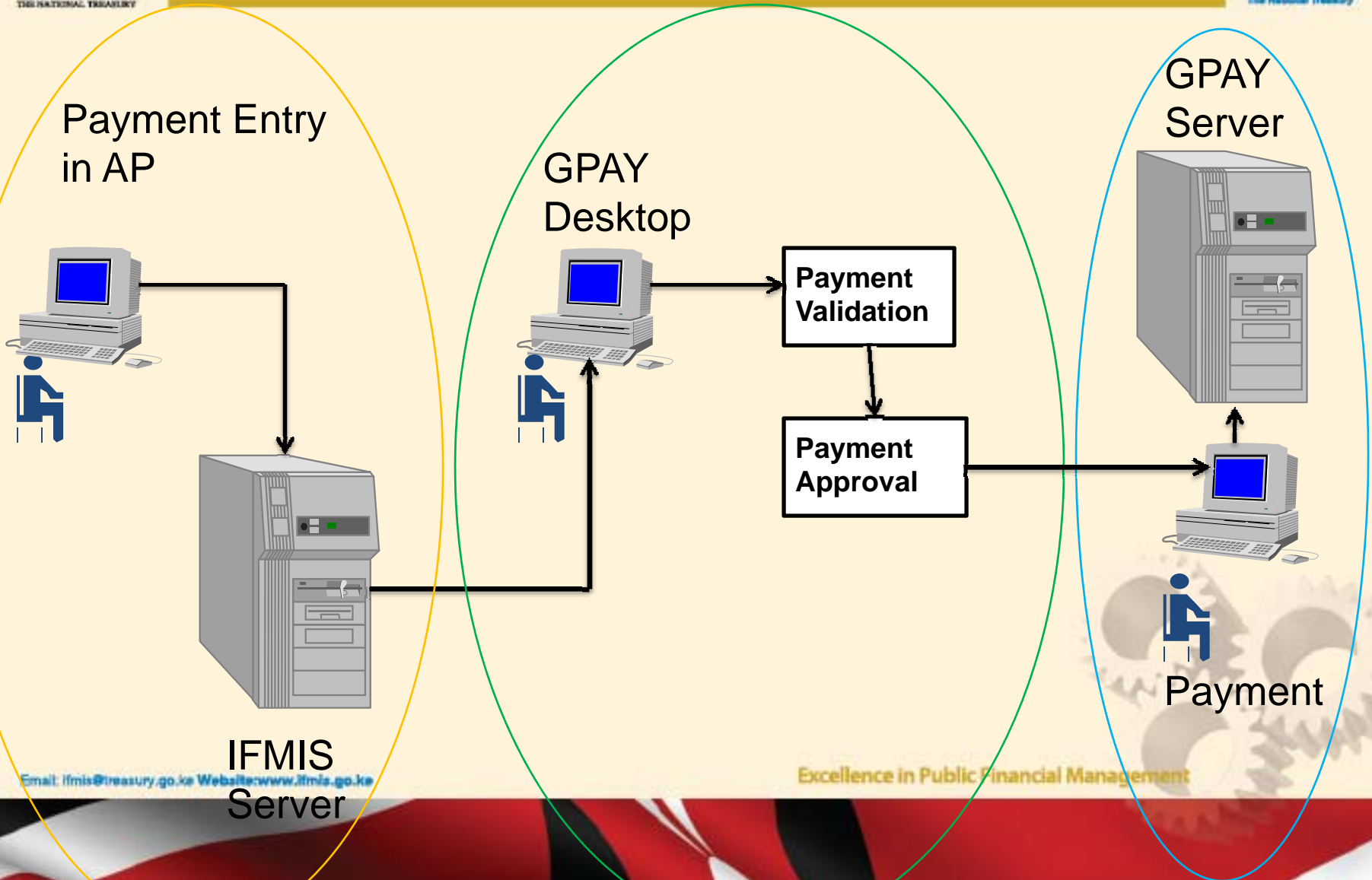

1. Limited e-Legislation to support transactions

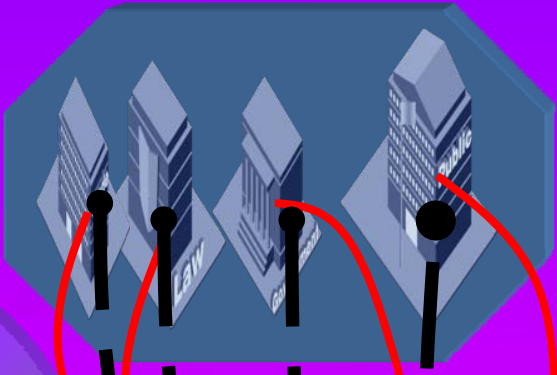
- *Some crimes related to ecommerce eg Cyber crime are not fully covered under the Act.*

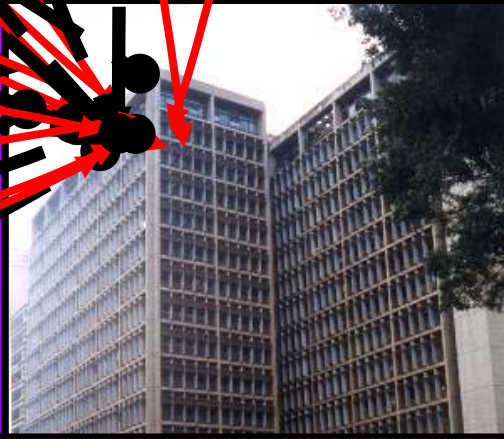
